Course Description

This course will introduce the language as well as aspects of life in Spain.

Week 1: Alphabet (learn pronunciation in Spanish) • Meeting and greeting people in Spanish • Asking and giving personal information • Verbs to be and to have

Week 2: Jobs/professions • Countries & nationalities • Masculine & feminine forms of nouns • Resources to ask about words (e.g. How do you spell...?, how do you say..?)

Week 3: Talking about hobbies • Numbers

Week 4: Express interests and intentions • Expressing why we do things • Prepositions

Week 5: Talking about your routine • Personal Pronouns • Definite article: el/la/los/las

Week 6: Describing places, countries, people and things • Adjectives • Indefinite article • Asking and saying what there is and there are • Asking and saying where places are

Week 7: Describing the weather • Relatives (where, how, what, when, how many, why etc) • Superlative (e.g. Barcelona is the biggest city in Spain).

Week 8: Asking and saying what you want in a shop • Demonstratives • Personal pronouns • Asking and saying how much something is • Describing and buying clothes • Colour adjectives

Week 9: Booking into a hotel • Saying days, dates, months • understanding a hotel bill • Describing houses, rooms and furniture • Uses of ser and estar. Describing changes

Week 10: Some food and drink • Ordering in a restaurant • Personal pronouns • Revision.
