Week 4: Lenses and what they can do.

Week 5: Composition and framing your subject.

Week 6: Uploading your images to a computer.

Week 7: Processing, an introduction to photo editing.

Weeks 8-10: Practical shooting session outside.

Be sure to bring your SLR camera to all sessions.
