

Woodturning

Course Description

During this 10 week course, participants will learn the basic skill of turning. You will work on a variety of projects, making your own pieces. All skill levels are welcome, from those with absolutely no previous experience, to those who have been turning for a while and who would like to learn new skills. Since there will be one lathe per student, you will have plenty of hands-on practice and ample tutor attention. This also allows you work at your own pace.

You will make a variety of items using a range of techniques. Typical items made include candlesticks, baby rattles, doorstops, table lamps, decorative mushrooms, eggcups, tealight holders, bowls and kitchen roll holders.

Materials (wood etc.) are not included in the cost of the course. Students can bring their own wood, or we can supply it for an additional fee. Cost will not be more than €25.

As woodturning produces sawdust and chippings old clothes should be worn.

Enrolment Details

Woodturning is one of our most popular courses and since class size is kept to just 8 students, they are often oversubscribed. Enrol early to avoid disappointment.

Courses will only be run if there are sufficient enrolment numbers. Course enrolment for a particular course may only be secured by full payment of course fee. Fees are strictly non-refundable unless the school decides not to run a course, in which case all fees will be refunded by post or directly to your credit card.
