Course Description

DIY, or Do It Yourself, is the method of modifying, repairing or building things without the direct aid of professionals or experts.

During this course you will learn how to complete a range of DIY projects, including tiling, plumbing, painting & decorating and electrics, within your own home. The exact topics taught will vary depending on what the class would like to cover, but will include many of the following:

Hanging pictures & curtain poles • Changing light bulbs & fuses • Tiling small areas of wall & floor • Constructing & installing shelving units • Painting & decorating • Fixing dripping taps • Clearing blocked drains & toilets • Basic Carpentry • Basic Gardening & outdoor Construction/Maintenance • Plastering & grouting etc • Wire a plug • Drilling holes • Cleaning gutters • Fixing squeaky floorboards • Resealing a bath • Building flat-pack furniture • Using a spirit level • Turning off the water Supply

The course will include some demonstration, and as much hands-on practice as possible, as you learn how to use hand and power tools and achieve a level of confidence required to carry out your own DIY projects.
